COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 10, “JOINT RESOLUTION MAKING SEPARATE APPLICATIONS TO THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES CALLING ARTICLE V CONVENTIONS TO PROPOSE AMENDMENTS ESTABLISHING TERM LIMITS FOR MEMBERS OF CONGRESS AND TERM LIMITS FOR JUSTICES OF THE UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT”

Amend the resolution by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'JOINT RESOLUTION MAKING APPLICATION TO THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES CALLING AN ARTICLE V CONVENTION TO PROPOSE AN AMENDMENT ESTABLISHING TERM LIMITS FOR MEMBERS OF CONGRESS'

Amend the resolution by inserting after the first resolved paragraph the following:

'RESOLVED: That the Legislature of Maine directs any delegates to a convention called for as a result of this application to be limited to considering and proposing amendments within the scope of this application; and be it further'

Amend the resolution by striking out all of the 3rd and 4th resolved paragraphs.

Amend the resolution in the 5th resolved paragraph in the first line by striking out the following: "these applications constitute continuing applications" and inserting the following: 'this application constitutes a continuing application'

Amend the resolution in the 5th resolved paragraph in the last line by striking out the following: "subjects" and inserting the following: 'subject'

Amend the resolution by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the provisions within the joint resolution making a separate application to the Congress of the United States calling an Article V convention to propose an amendment establishing term limits for justices of the United States Supreme Court.
