The ICP-MS instrument enables the analysis of environmental metals in both drinking water and non-potable water samples. HETL's current ICP-MS instrument frequently runs at maximum capacity. This additional instrument will allow for increased testing reducing delays in reporting results and the ability to determine arsenic speciation. This instrument also provides the potential for additional analysis such as arsenic in marine samples and mercury, chromium, and antimony speciation in cooperation with other state agencies. Awareness campaigns have increased the demand for water analysis. By providing test results with arsenic speciation without delay, Maine's residents will be able to make more informed decisions about their water treatment options. Funds are no longer required in the All Other line category for the purpose for which they were originally intended due to a reduction in supplies expenditures.
