### Statement of Fact

This financial order provides allotment in the Capital Expenditures line category through a transfer from the All Other line category to purchase equipment. The Health and Environmental Testing Lab within the Department of Health and Human Services needs to replace a piece of equipment and accessories to test public water supplies. This automated equipment is called the ManSci system. The lab already owns the software, analyzer and PH probes designed to function with the ManSci system. Public water supplies require testing to be completed within 10 days of receipt. This testing, if conducted manually, is very time-consuming. Delays in testing could result in the public water supply being in violation of the Drinking Water Programs mandate, resulting in the water supply receiving a failure to monitor violation. Funds are no longer required in the All Other line category due to savings in office and other supplies. Failure to approve this financial order jeopardizes the ability to perform tests for the public in a timely manner.

### Statement of Fact

This financial order will allot a portion of the unencumbered balance forward to fund a professional services contract with the University of Southern Maine (USM). The funds will be used for the "Cybersecurity Outreach Research Project" beginning in the Spring of 2020. Students will conduct research to identify populations in Maine that are either not adept with digital technologies and/or at-risk from online scams and fraud. Project coordinators will then determine how best to train those groups that have been identified, including the use of workshops facilitated by the Office of Securities to increase their digital awareness and help protect themselves against online threats. It is estimated that ten students working ten hours a week annually will be required. This program enables the Office of Securities' Investor Education program to fulfill one of its primary functions which is to develop and implement investor education initiatives focused on the prevention and detection of securities fraud. Failure to approve this financial order will leave the program unable to fulfill one of its primary functions.
