

This position is funded by the All Other contract savings. These funds are no longer required in the All Other line category for the purpose for which they were intended due to contract savings. Bureau of Highway Safety will administer the grant which includes coordination with local event organizers and community leaders as well as promotion to increase awareness of impaired driving alternatives. Statement of Fact

This financial order increases allotment in the Capital Expenditures line category to purchase 2 universal forensic extraction devices (UFED) for the State Police Computer Crimes Unit. The UFED is the primary forensic tool used to extract critical data from the majority of cellular phones submitted for analysis by law enforcement. This device can be used in the collection of evidence for the majority of cases involving mobile data, but is predominantly used in child exploitation cases. The increase of mobile devices submitted as evidence along with the recent addition of two new computer forensic analysts means that additional devices are needed to maintain the daily operational demands of evidence processing. Funding is derived from the U.S. Department of Justice's Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Program which helps state and local law enforcement agencies develop an effective response to technology facilitated child sexual exploitation. Failure to approve this order will result in the loss of federal funds and inability to purchase the needed devices.
