Be it further ordered,

that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2020", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

## Statement of Fact

The Maine Department of Marine Resources (MDMR) has received funding from the Keepers of Burnt Island Light (KBIL) for the purpose of restoration, preservation and maintenance of Burnt Island and its historic buildings. Burnt Island and its associated lighthouse are owned by the Maine Department of Marine Resources, which manages and operates the property as a public educational and recreational facility. KBIL is a 501 (c) (3) charitable and educational non-profit organization formed to support the restoration, preservation and maintenance of Burnt Island and its historic buildings. Upon execution of the memorandum of agreement by the parties KBIL will donate funds to MDMR in the amount of \$296,778.19. MDMR will conditionally accept the funds, to be used exclusively for the cost of restoration of the Burnt Island Lighthouse.
