H, §2, is 16 further amended to read: 17 18 1-B. Additional exemption. A homestead eligible for an exemption under subsection 19 1 is eligible for an additional exemption of \$5,000 of the just value of the homestead for 20 property tax years beginning on April 1, 2016, \$10,000 of the just value of the homestead 21 for property tax years beginning on April 1, 2017, April 1, 2018 and April 1, 2019 and 22 \$15,000 of the just value of the homestead for property tax years beginning on or after 23 April 1, 2020 and April 1, 2021 and \$20,000 of the just value of the homestead for property 24 tax years beginning on or after April 1, 2022.' 25 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 26 number to read consecutively. 27 SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment increases the total homestead

property tax exemption from \$25,000 to \$30,000 beginning April 1, 2022.
