Statement of Fact

The Office of the Attorney General requests authority to establish one limited-period Assistant Attorney General position. The position will be assigned to the Natural Resources Division. Funding for this position is split between the Department of Environmental Protection, Department of Marine Resources, Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, and Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. The position will provide legal services to natural resources agencies including litigation, settlement review and negotiation, rulemaking assistance and review, and other consultation as needed. The position will be effective on October 1, 2021 and will end on June 11, 2022. This financial order allots funding through June 30, 2022. In fiscal year 2022-23, another financial order will be submitted to extend the position and allot funds.

That the State Controller increase allotment in account 014-13A-0258-16, Marine Science, Management, and Enforcement Fund, by \$28,941 in the All Other line category for the purpose of allotting a portion of the unencumbered balance forward to purchase sound detection monitors, inReach satellite technology, and uniforms; and,

Be it further ordered,

that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward for contractual research and design services, to purchase sound detection monitors, Garmin inReach satellite technology, and uniforms for the Bureau of Marine Patrol (BMP). BMP is acquiring a new vessel with a Tier 4 diesel engine. Tier 4 diesel technology reduces emissions of particulate matter and oxides of nitrogen to near zero levels but requires exhaust temperatures that pose a challenge aboard a fiberglass lobster boat. BMP will contract with the vessel manufacturer to design the Tier 4 technology safely into the future vessel build. This order also funds sound detection monitors that will allow BMP to measure sound levels to evaluate and enforce noise limitations on watercraft and airboats. Garmin inReach satellite technology will be used on the larger BMP vessels for two-way communication and location services in areas without cell service. These funds are received from the sale of items or articles forfeited resulting from a violation of law relating to a particular species. Failure to allot these funds will have a detrimental impact to the BMP's enforcement and public safety efforts.
