# Statement of Fact

This financial order provides funding to establish seven limited-period positions to establish, expand, train, and sustain the state, local, and territorial public health workforce. These positions will support COVID-19 prevention, preparedness, response, and recovery initiatives, including school-based health programs, which will close gaps in statewide capacity emphasized by COVID-19 across multiple programs. The school-based health program initiatives will mainly focus on sustainable solutions, through the use of technology and telehealth options, for small schools where school nurses are less available. These positions are funded by the Public Health Crisis Response grant through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 and will start February 14, 2022 and end February 13, 2024.

### Statement of Fact

This financial order provides funding to establish five limited-period positions to support work related to the federal COVID-19 Health Disparities grant awarded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention through the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021. Examples of populations considered to be high risk are women, LGBTQ+ individuals, and persons with disabilities. Three positions will be placed within the Office of Population Health Equity to ensure the goals of the grant are met and will be responsible for monitoring projects and providing fiscal oversight, resulting in an increase in data collection and reporting for those populations experiencing a disproportionate burden of COVID-19 infection, severe illness, and death. The Public Service Coordinator II position will support the enhancement of MaineCare member communications and interface with data activities. The Management Analyst II will support the enhancement of data platforms and gather and interpret health disparity data. These positions will start on January 30, 2022 and end on May 20, 2023.
