2030	2676	3/23			An Act Regarding Taxation of Energy Storage Facilities and Equipment	<p>This bill creates a ST exemption for sales of commercial energy storage systems; integral parts and accessories for such a system; and materials for the construction, repair or maintenance of such a system.</p> <p>The bill also provides that BETE is available for energy storage systems.</p> <p>“Energy storage system” means “commercial equipment, facilities or devices that are capable of absorbing energy, storing energy for a period of time and discharging the energy after it has been stored.”</p>	3/16
