Funding for the entire fiscal year 2022-23 was already provided in Financial Order CV0445 F3 therefore no additional allotment is needed. The COVID-19 pandemic highlighted and expanded the role of the school nurse both at the local and state levels. These positions serve as School Nurse Specialists to provide statewide school nursing leadership, consultation and direction on the Coordinated School Health team within the Office of School and Student Supports. These positions are needed in order to maintain continuity of this critical resource. An initiative has been submitted in the 2024-2025 biennial budget to continue the positions permanently.

Statement of Fact

This financial order provides allotment to fund contractual obligations to strengthen Maine's crisis service system through the development of qualifying community-based mobile crisis intervention services in the Medicaid program and to pay for estimated Office of Information Technology (OIT) bills. Contractual obligations include the Open Beds Service Locator Tool and a contracted project director position. The grant has been extended and additional funding is required to ensure project management and compliance. Existing available allotment intended for these contracts was needed for an unbudgeted increase in contracted staffing costs. States that provide qualifying mobile crisis services are eligible for 85% Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP). Funding is provided by the State Planning Grants for Qualifying Community-Based Mobile Crisis Intervention Services authorized by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.
