## Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill provides an annual 3-day sales tax holiday the second weekend in November beginning in 2023. It will reduce General Fund revenue by \$16,912,850 in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$17,013,550 in fiscal year 2024-25. It will also reduce Local Government Fund revenue by \$890,150 in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$895,450 in fiscal year 2024-25.
