Eliminates Class D and Class E crimes and civil violations.
A reduction in fines will decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Allowing junior hunters to take one antlerless deer without an antlerless deer permit could result in a minor decrease in antlerless deer permits sold, leading to a minor decrease in General Fund revenue not requiring any change to the budget.
