Fiscal Detail and Notes

The consumer education program related to the implementation of competition in the retail electricity markets and the impact on consumers has ended. This bill transfers the remaining balance of \$747.96 in the Public Utilities Commission Consumer Education Fund to the Office of Public Advocate and allocates that amount for consumer education related to the electricity industry.
