COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

1	SUMMARY
2	This amendment replaces the concept draft. It simplifies the process of calculating
3	dairy stabilization tier program payments by eliminating additions to the statistical
4	uniform blend price when determining the base price for comparison with the so-called
5	tier safety net levels. The amendment also eliminates the distribution of 1/2 of 1% of the
6	casino slot machine income to the Maine Milk Pool that is scheduled to begin July 1,
7	2013 and increases the net slot machine income distribution to the Dairy Improvement
8	Fund from 1/2 of 1% to 1% on that date. The amendment also adds an emergency
9	preamble and emergency clause.
