SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to S.P. 438, L.D. 1277, Bill, “An Act To Streamline the Charitable Solicitations Act”

Amend the amendment in section 13 in paragraph D in the 4th and 5th lines (page 2, lines 6 and 7 in amendment) by striking out the following: "all fund-raising activities are carried on by persons who are unpaid for their services" and inserting the following: 'all fund-raising activities are carried on by persons who are unpaid for their services the charitable organizations do not contract with professional solicitors or professional fund-raising counsel'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment includes a change inadvertently left out of Committee Amendment "A" providing an exemption from licensure for charitable organizations that do not contract with professional solicitors or professional fund-raising counsel.
