House Paper 584, Legislative Document 835, "An Act To Promote Small Diversified Farms and Small Food Producers," having been returned by the Governor, together with objections to the same, pursuant to Article IV, Part Third, Section 2 of the Constitution of the State of Maine, after reconsideration, the House proceeded to vote on the question: "Shall this Bill become a law notwithstanding the objections of the Governor?"

83 voted in favor and 47 against, with 1 being excused, and accordingly it was the vote of the House that the Bill not become a law and the veto was sustained.
