WHEREAS, the Legislature has learned with deep regret of the death of:

(4-8) Martin Engstrom, of Fryeburg. Mr. Engstrom was a veteran of the United States Air Force who served as a weapons control technician. After his service, he became a broadcast engineer. He had a long career with Portland-area television station WMTW running the station's transmitter on the summit of Mount Washington, from which he also broadcast weather reports for 38 years. With a Maine accent so thick some viewers thought it must be fake and wearing a clip-on bow tie, he read his reports from hand-written cue cards he taped to the camera. His folksy, unpolished style made him a hit, and he was affectionately known by the public as "Marty on the Mountain." He retired from WMTW in 2002 and was inducted into the Maine Association of Broadcasters Hall of Fame in 2019. Mr. Engstrom will be long remembered and sadly missed by his family and friends and all those whose lives he touched;
