**Non-Concurrent Matter**

(1-1) HOUSE REPORTS - from the Committee on **EDUCATION AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS** on Bill "An Act to Strengthen Maine Citizens' Second Amendment Rights by Allowing the Discharge of Firearms on Private Property That Is Within 500 Feet of School Property in Certain Circumstances"

H.P. 344 L.D. 525

Majority - **Ought Not to Pass** (8 members)

Minority - **Ought to Pass** (5 members)

In Senate, June 13, 2025, the Minority **OUGHT TO PASS** Report **READ** and **ACCEPTED** and the Bill **PASSED TO BE ENGROSSED** in **NON-CONCURRENCE**.

Comes from the House, that Body having **INSISTED** on its former action whereby the Majority **OUGHT NOT TO PASS** Report was **READ** and **ACCEPTED**.

**EMERGENCY**

(1-2) An Act to Provide That Spouses and Children of Corrections Officers Who Die in the Line of Duty Receive a Pension

H.P. 733 L.D. 1114  
(C "A" H-597)

In Senate, June 13, 2025, **FAILED ENACTMENT** in **NON-CONCURRENCE**.

Comes from the House, that Body having **INSISTED** on its former action whereby the Bill was **PASSED TO BE ENACTED**.

(1-3) HOUSE REPORTS - from the Committee on **STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT** on Bill "An Act to Replace Participation Thresholds with Approval Thresholds in Certain School, Municipal and County Measures"

H.P. 1002 L.D. 1517

Report "A" - **Ought to Pass as Amended by Committee Amendment "A" (H-578)** (6 members)

Report "B" - **Ought Not to Pass** (6 members)

In Senate, June 13, 2025, Report "A", **OUGHT TO PASS AS AMENDED, FAILED.** Subsequently, Report "B", **OUGHT NOT TO PASS, READ** and **ACCEPTED** in **NON-CONCURRENCE.**

Comes from the House, that Body having **INSISTED** on its former action whereby Report "A", **OUGHT TO PASS AS AMENDED**, was **READ** and **ACCEPTED** and the Bill **PASSED TO BE ENGROSSED AS AMENDED BY COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-578).**

**Non-Concurrent Matter**

(1-4) HOUSE REPORTS - from the Committee on **JUDICIARY** on Bill "An Act to Allow Municipalities to Prohibit Firearms Within Their Municipal Buildings and Voting Places and at Their Municipal Public Proceedings"

H.P. 1161 L.D. 1743

Majority - **Ought to Pass** (7 members)

Minority - **Ought Not to Pass** (6 members)

In Senate, June 12, 2025, the Majority **OUGHT TO PASS** Report **READ** and **ACCEPTED** and the Bill **PASSED TO BE ENGROSSED** in **NON-CONCURRENCE.**

Comes from the House, that Body having **INSISTED** on its former action whereby the Minority **OUGHT NOT TO PASS** Report was **READ** and **ACCEPTED.**
